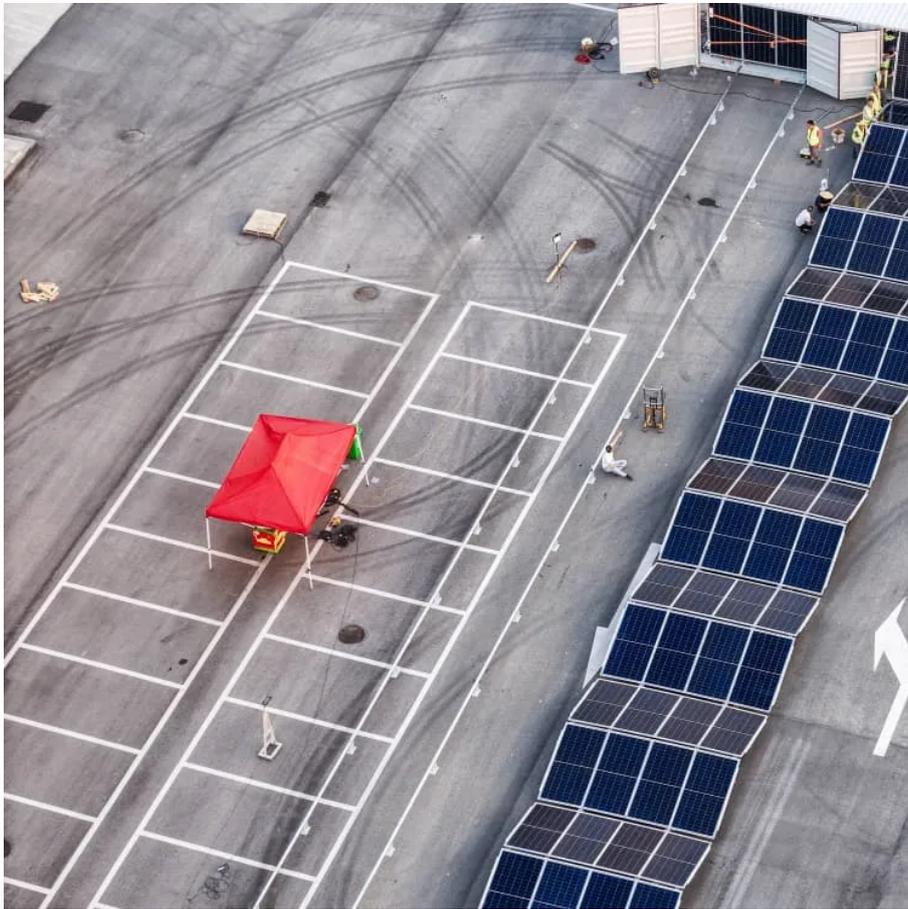

The Australian government has announced an ambitious plan to provide households in three states with at least three hours of free solar power every day - even if they don't have rooftop panels. The "solar sharer" scheme, set to launch in July 2026, covers homes with smart meters across New South.
