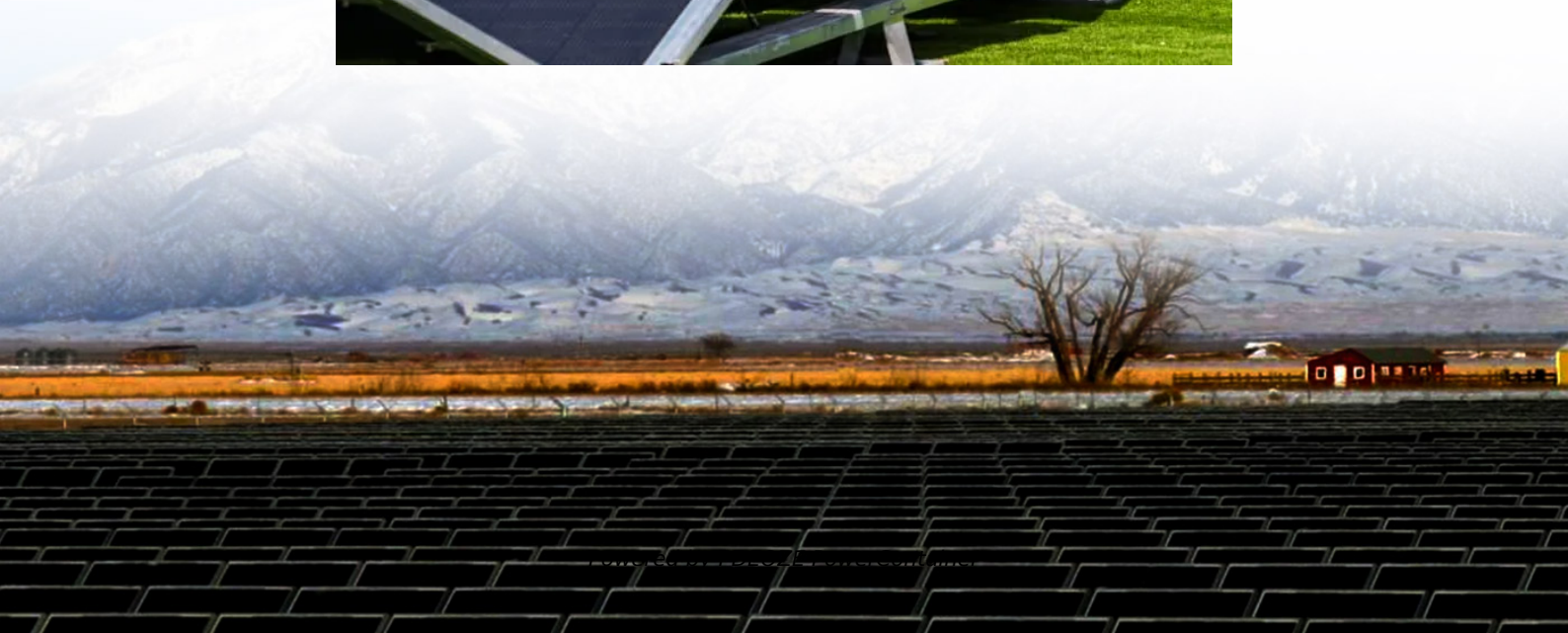

Hello i have a new power supply and was wondering if psus can be installed on its side because i want to buy this very nice case due to its amazing air flow but on the back panel u can see that the psu is on its side here is the info to my PUS and too the case. please tell me psus can work on its.

I know that psu can be placed sideways. There are pc cases like that. But doesn't that hurt the fan over time?

It isn't the same as if it where placed horizontal. Where weight is balanced. Sideways the fan weight is not balanced as it sits vertical. Especially psu that have zero rpm. As they sit.

Leaked images of an upcoming Corsair power supply with an innovative design make us wonder why no one's done this before. I think this is garbage. Not only does it violate the ATX spec, very few cases have enough space behind the motherboard to comfortably fit those connectors facing that way. In.

My 2-gang exterior outlets are installed horizontally (which is fine) with the receptical in the standard orientation which puts the two blade connectors horizontal and the ground connection on the side. This works just fine until I want to plug two three-prong plugs in. Many plugs have the prongs.

However 2 of their cases I've looked so far mount their PSU sideways. Can this be harmful to the PSU in the longrun?

Has anyone have any issues with this kind of PSU Orientation?

## Can the outdoor power supply be used sideways

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Many plugs have the prongs on the side rather than on the end. When this cord is plugged in, it blocks the 2nd outlet. What I want is an outlet with the connectors oriented toward the side. The only place I have ...

It seems like you can do it both ways, but you might want the PSU fan pulling more air through your cooler, but the PSU will be a bit hotter so the fan will run more often.

Hey friend, it would be difficult to modify that type of power supply for outdoor use. It just wasn't designed for that application and its safety and reliability would be suspect.

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It doesn't matter because it's an uninterruptible power supply, do it's impossible to interrupt it's power output regardless of what orientation it's in, whether it's on fire, in water, in space, etc

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It's fine mounting the unit in any orientation. Even upsidedown is ok. It is perfectly safe, there are a lot of cases that mount them upside down and sideways. My case mounts it

sideways ...

I've been using an old enermax for a week on its side, no problems so far. Picking up a new pc power & cooling silncer 750 in a few days, I'll give it a go. I've just heard horror ...

Yep, just used it in my latest build and I was glad I chose it over the regular design.

Yes, if the mounting holes are there and the bottom of the case is vented. Yes, that is usually the intended way to mount a bottom mount PSU.
