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Cape Verde Solar Grid-Connected System



Overview

A clean energy mini grid powered by solar power has been opened on the Island of Fogo, Cabo Verde, as part of efforts to provide universal access to electricity to its inhabitants for the first time.

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Cabo Verde has launched the second phase of its flagship Palmarejo Solar Plant on Santiago Island, a project that will more than double the facility's generating capacity and strengthen renewable energy supply to the capital region. The expansion, referred to locally as Palmarejo II, will upgrade.

Expanding renewable energy capacity and improving grid efficiency to reduce dependency on imported fossil fuels and lower energy costs are among several key "immediate priorities" that Cabo Verde need to address.
