France's first 5G 3.5 GHz SA network Free currently has the largest 5G mobile network in France, with over 20,000 5G sites in service, including 6,950 3.5 GHz sites. Available in almost 10,500 municipalities, it already covers nearly 95% of the French population.

In addition, a total of 819,000 5G base stations have been built by these three
