

Syria's Ministry of Energy has signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with US-based 20Solar Energy to develop 200 MW solar PV capacity, as part of its plans to support the national grid with diversification of energy generation. One of the projects under the MoU will be a vanilla solar PV.
