Mauritania launches a pioneering hybrid solar-wind plant with integrated storage, ensuring reliable power and accelerating universal energy access. Mauritania has initiated a significant energy development by signing public-private partnership agreements for a 220 MW hybrid solar-wind power plant.

The Mauritanian government has signed an agreement with renewable energy company Ewa Green Energy for the construction of a \$300 million hybrid power plant combining solar and wind generation. The facility will have a total capacity of 220 MW, with 160 MW from solar and 60 MW from wind. It will.

Mauritania is shifting to a fully privatized power generation model, leveraging its natural gas reserves and renewable energy potential to expand electricity access, drive industrialization and attract investment. As part of this transition, the government will no longer pursue state-led power.
